Government-linked private equity firm Ekuiti Nasional Bhd (Ekuinas) has announced that its inaugural chairman, Raja Tan Sri Arshad Raja Tun Uda, will be stepping down from his role effective July 18, 2023, after steering the firm since its establishment in 2009.
